Beginning December 1, 2019 Stevens Disposal is excited to partner with Frenchtown Charter Township for the collection of your household and yard waste needs.

There will be minimal changes to your current collection process however, the most important change for you to know is that Frenchtown Charter Township has chosen to eliminate curbside recycle collection. While this might be concerning, it is driven by the current state of recycling nationwide, contamination rate and cost associated to process recycled material. This change will give a substantial cost savings to Frenchtown Charter Township over the term of the new contract and is being adapted in many municipalities nationwide.

Below are other important items to make note of that will become effective December 1, 2019:

 Stevens Disposal will deliver one new 96-gallon cart the week of November 18th 2019 to be used starting December 1st 2019.

(this cart is registered by serial number to you address, please do not move to another address).

- 2. **Service Days:** Friday will be added to the collection schedule by taking small portions from Monday through Thursday routes. Please consult the map on the reverse side of this document for your collection day.
- 3. Your carts should be set curbside either night before or **no later than 6:00am** on collection day.
- 4. **Prohibited items include but, may not be limited to the following:** Liquid filled containers of any kind, building/construction material i.e. wood, brick, concrete, asphalt, rocks, automotive parts & tires, hazardous waste material. Refrigeration units must have refringent removed and tagged by a licensed technician.
- 5. Bulk items must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance of collection day by calling Stevens Disposal @ 800– 779-0344 or the Township office @ 734-242-3282 Ext. 3.
- 6. Yard Waste the collection of yard waste will be on the same day as your household trash. The season dates will be determined annually by the Township. (Generally, sometime in April through November or early December depending on weather). Material must be placed in a container clearly labeled as "YARD WASTE" (stickers available at the township office) or in Kraft paper yard waste bags. "NO PLASTIC BAGS PLEASE". Limbs cannot be larger than 1" in diameter and 4' in length bundled/tied or taped 24" in diameter or less.
- 7. Christmas trees will be collected on your normal collection day January 2nd through January 16th.
- Holiday Schedule Stevens Disposal will observe the following six major holidays and will run your collection schedule one day behind. i.e. Christmas December 25th is Thursday so your collection day will move to Friday the 26th and Friday collection will move to Saturday the 27th.

New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day
